**ITEM TITLE:**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 2, "ADMINISTRATION," ARTICLE III, "BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES," DIVISION 6, "WATERWAY ADVISORY BOARD," TO REVISE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE WATERWAY ADVISORY BOARD AND THE QUALIFICATIONS OF WATERWAY ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

The City Code currently provides that the Waterway Advisory Board (the "Board") shall be composed of eight (8) City residents who live along specified City waterways and coastal areas and one other (1) City resident. The City Commission finds that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to revise the composition of the Board and the qualifications for Board membership.

On first reading, this Ordinance changed the size of the Board to eight (8) members, allocated five (5) seats to City residents who live along specified City waterways and coastal areas, allocated one (1) seat for a City resident who does not reside along a City waterway or coastal area, allocated one (1) seat for an individual with expertise in a water-related science, and allocated one (1) seat for a representative of the University of Miami.

Since first reading, the Ordinance has been changed to add an additional board member, bringing the total number of Waterway Advisory Board members to nine (9). The additional seat shall be allocated for a City resident.
