SUBJECT: Transportation Alternatives Program Granada Blvd. Sidewalk Improvement Program

The selection process for the 2025 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Program has been successfully completed, following FDOT's notice from June 17, 2025, and collaboration with the Miami-Dade TPO.

On May 29, 2025, the Miami-Dade TPO Governing Board approved the 2027-2031 Priority Projects list. I'm pleased to share that the City of Coral Gables' Granada Boulevard Sidewalk Improvement Project made the list.

The project has been allocated \$950,200 to cover design, construction, and engineering through fiscal years 2028 and 2030.

I am pleased to receive this funding, as sidewalks are a vital part of our community's infrastructure. They enhance connectivity, safety, and walkability—values we deeply prioritize. Supporting sidewalks has been a priority throughout my tenure serving the city, and I'm glad to see these efforts come to fruition with this important project moving forward.
