RESOLUTION NO. 2010-_____

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE EXISTING CONTRACT WITH MICRO SECURITY SOLUTIONS FOR A PERIOD THROUGH MAY 31, 2010 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000 FOR SECURITY EQUIPMENT INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CCTV SYSTEMS, ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEMS, FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS AND ALL ASSOCIATED SOFTWARE, HARDWARE AND ACCESSORIES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2008-73, Micro Security Solutions' contract for providing security equipment installation and maintenance expired June 1, 2009 and this Resolution seeks to extend Micro Security Solutions' contract for an additional one year in order to complete the design and installation of various security systems at the Coral Gables Museum, Police Department and Coral Gables Youth Center in addition to providing citywide security equipment installation and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the design and installation of the security system at the Coral Gables Museum is not completed and requires the continuation of services by Micro Security Solutions to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, by May 31, 2010, it is expected that the procurement process to bring a new security systems vendor on board with the City will be completed; and

WHEREAS, funding for services by Micro Security Solutions is appropriated in the FY 2009-2010 Budget and shall become available as the project is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals and "Whereas" clauses contained in the preamble to this Resolution are hereby adopted by reference and incorporated herein as if fully set forth in this Section.

SECTION 2. That the extension of the existing contract with Micro Security Solutions for a period through May 31, 2010 in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for security equipment installation and maintenance of CCTV Systems, Access Control Systems, Fire Alarm Systems and all associated software, hardware and accessories is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
