

# **CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA**

## **DRAFT RESOLUTION \_\_\_\_\_**

### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BY AND AMONG MIAM-DADE COUNTY, THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY OFFICE OF THE PROPERTY APPRAISER, AND THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES FOR COLLECTING SOLID WASTE NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS FOR THE COST OF PROVIDING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City intends to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments authorized in section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, as amended, for collecting solid waste non-ad valorem assessments for the cost of providing solid waste collection services. Such non-ad valorem assessments shall be levied within the incorporated area of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to properly utilize the uniform method of collection, the City has requested that the Property Appraiser and Tax Collector include its adopted non-ad valorem assessments for the collection of solid waste services to property within the incorporated area of the City on the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and Non-Ad Valorem Assessments specified in Section 200.069, Florida Statutes (the "TRIM Notice"), and on the Combined Notice of Ad Valorem and Non-Ad Valorem Assessments provided for in Section 197.3635, Florida Statutes (the "Tax Bill"). Pursuant to Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, the City, Tax Collector and Property Appraiser must enter into a written agreement evidencing the Tax Collector's and Property Appraiser's agreement to place the City's specified non-ad valorem assessments on the TRIM Notice and Tax Bill.

### **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**Section 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**Section 2.** That the City of Coral Gables authorizes the execution of an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement by and among Miami-Dade County and the City of Coral Gables.

**Section 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
