ITEM TITLE:

Resolution. A Resolution of the City Commission authorizing the acceptance of the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) grant funds in the amount of \$200,000 to the newly designed and built Toledo & Alava Neighborhood Park which is located at the corner of Alava Avenue and Toledo Street, Coral Gables, Florida; and authorizing an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Annual Budget to recognize the \$200,000 grant as revenue and to appropriate such funds to put toward the cost of the program.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION:

BRIEF HISTORY:

This agreement authorizes the acceptance, execution, and budget amendment of \$200,000 as part of a matching grant from the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) for the City of Coral Gables. FRDAP is a competitive grant program that provides state funds for the acquisition or development of lands for public outdoor recreational use. All county governments and incorporated municipalities of the state of Florida and other legally constituted local governmental entities with the legal responsibility for the provision of outdoor recreational sites and facilities for the use and benefit of the public.

The funds will be used for new walking trail, play structure and surface, picnic facilities, benches, landscaping, lighting, fencing, waste receptacles, drinking fountain and mister spray for the Toledo & Alava Neighborhood Park.
