ACTION/RECOMMENDATION

I nominate Officer Christian Crespo and Officer Alexander Rodriguez to receive the Officer of the Month Award for their immediate response and quick apprehension of a felony subject as noted below.

BACKGROUND

On Monday, November 9th, 2020, at approximately 6:40 a.m., Coral Gables Police units responded in emergency mode to the area of the 400-Block of Zamora Avenue reference to an unknown subject wearing all black clothing seen breaking into a black Jeep vehicle. The reporter further advised CGPD communications that the subject was still inside the vehicle.

Officer Crespo was the first officer to arrive on scene at approximately 6:42 a.m., when he observed the listed black Jeep vehicle parked in the driveway of 421 Zamora Avenue. Officer Crespo immediately exited his marked police vehicle and confronted a white male matching the description exiting the listed vehicle from the right front passenger door. Officer Crespo instructed the offender to get on the ground as he held him at gun point. The offender at no point obeyed Officer Crespo's verbal commands and swiftly walked in front of the vehicle as he back peddled away from him eastbound on the 400-block of Zamora Avenue.

Officer Rodriguez was the second officer to arrive on scene at approximately 6:43 a.m., when he exited his marked police vehicle and heard Officer Crespo give loud and clear commands to the offender to stop and get on the ground. The offender did not comply and proceeded to walk away from Officer Crespo eastbound on the 400-block of Zamora Avenue and stated, "Why do I need to stop?" Officer Rodriguez approached the offender and gave him loud and clear commands to stop, he proceeded to run eastbound on the 400-block of Zamora Avenue away from Officer Crespo and Officer Rodriguez. Officer Crespo and Officer Rodriguez engaged in a foot pursuit in attempt to apprehend the offender. Officer Crespo and Officer Rodriguez ran parallel to each other as they ran after the offender. The offender did not stop and kept running, prior to reaching LeJeune Road, Officer Rodriguez drew his department issued Taser 7 and deployed one cartridge while running and aiming at the offender's mid back area. The Taser deployment had a negative effect on the offender. The offender continued to run eastbound and resist arrest. Shortly after the first deployment, Officer Rodriguez deployed a second Taser cartridge along the 400-block of

Zamora Avenue, while running and aiming at the offender's mid back area. The second deployment also had a negative affect and might have contacted an umbrella, which was being carried by the offender. Shortly after Officer Rodriguez's second Taser deployment, Officer Crespo drew his department issued Taser 7 and deployed one cartridge, while running and aiming at the offender's mid back area. One of the taser prongs appears to have contacted the offender's back; however, the deployment had a negative affect and did not fully incapacitate the offender.

The offender continued to run in an eastbound direction and crossed LeJeune Road as Officer Crespo and Officer Rodriguez continued to run after him. The offender ran onto the east side sidewalk and stumbled on the southwest grass area of 4138 SW 16 Terrace (Havana Air). As the offender was in a prone position, Officer Rodriguez approached the right side of the offender and placed his right shin onto his right shoulder blade, while Officer Crespo was on the offender's left side. Both officers attempted to place him in restraints. The offender placed his arms under his chest area and braced tightly while both officers attempted to pull his arms free. The offender would not free them. Shortly after, both officers were able to gain control of the offender's arms and place him into custody. The offender was quickly placed in a recovery position.

Coral Gables Fire Rescue responded to the scene, treated, and transported the offender to Doctor's Hospital (For further details refer to Coral Gables EMS Case # 20-006566). The offender was checked for injuries and it was confirmed that one of the Taser prongs contacted his back causing a red bruise. The offender was treated for his injuries at the listed hospital. It was determined that the subject removed the prong by unknown means prior to being taken into custody.

The listed incident was dispatched during inclement weather as units worked under Hurricane ETA all night and approached the last few hours of their shift. Both officers stayed after their shift approximately 5-6 hours working on the Arrest Affidavit, Incident Report, Supplement Report, Impounded Property, and conducted a Taser Data Download with our Training Section.


Due to both officers' immediately response to the vehicle burglary in process the offender was apprehended, and a felony arrest was made.

Based on the aforementioned, I request the listed Officers receive the Officer of the Month Award for their joint response and apprehension efforts.





IN THE DRIVEWAY OF 421 ZAMORA AVENUE. AS I EXITED MY MARKED POLICE VEHICLE, I WAS ABLE TO OBSERVE A MALE FITTING THE DESCRIPTION (MR. KHOURY/DEFENDANT) EXIT THE LISTED VEHICLE IN QUESTION, AND CLOSE THE RIGHT FRONT PASSENGER DOOR. I ORDERED MR. KHOURY TO SHOW ME HIS HANDS AND GAVE HIM MULTIPLE VERBAL COMMANDS TO GET ON THE GROUND AS I HELD HIM AT GUN POINT. MR. KHOURY AT NO POINT OBEYED MY COMMANDS AND SWIFTLY WALKED IN FRONT OF THE VEHICLE AS HE BACK PEDDLED AWAY FROM ME HEADING EASTBOUND ALONG THE 400-BLK OF ZAMORA AV. AT THAT POINT, OFFICER A. RODRIGUEZ (ID #11241) ARRIVED ON SCENE. I THEN PROCEEDED TO APPROACH MR. KOURY WHEN HE ABRUPTLY TURNED AROUND AND STARTED TO SPRINT EASTBOUND APPROACHING LEJEUNE ROAD. OFFICER RODRIGUEZ AND I ENGAGED IN A FOOT PURSUIT AFTER MR. KHOURY IN EFFORTS TO TAKE THE HIM INTO CUSTODY. WHILE RUNNING BEHIND THE SUBJECT, MULTIPLE TASER DEPLOYMENTS WERE INITIATED BY OFFICER RODRIGUEZ AND I WHICH WERE ALL INEFFECTIVE IN ACHIEVING MUSCULAR INCAPACITATION. MR. KHOURY WAS ABLE TO CROSS THE INTERSECTION OF ZAMORA AVENUE AND LEJEUNE ROAD, WHERE HE WAS FINALLY TAKEN INTO CUSTODY ON THE WESTSIDE OF 4138 SW 16 TERRACE (HAVANA AIR). WHILE ATTEMPTING TO RESTRAIN THE DEFENDANT, I APPROACHED THE LEFT SIDE OF THE DEFENDANT, AS HE PLACED HIS ARMS UNDER HIS CHEST AREA AND BRACED TIGHTLY WHILE I ATTEMPTED TO PULL HIS ARMS FREE. THE DEFENDANT WOULD NOT FREE HIS ARMS TO ASSIST WITH BEING RESTRAINED. I WAS ABLE TO TAKE CONTROL OF THE DEFENDANT'S LEFT ARM AND PLACE HIS ARM BEHIND HIS BACK TO SUCCESSFULLY TAKE HIM INTO CUSTODY. A BLACK UMBRELLA WHICH WAS IN MR. KHOURYS POSSESSION WAS CONFIRMED TO BELONG TO MS. RAFAELA TAVLID BRITO DUQUE (VICTIM/OWNER OF THE LISTED VEHICLE).

MS. BRITO DUQUE WAS ABLE TO CONFIRM WITH OFFICER SMITH SHE HAD NEVER MET MR. KHOURY AND AT NO POINT DID SHE EVER GIVE HIM PERMISSION TO ENTER HER PROPERTY AND SCAVENGE THROUGH HER 2020 BLACK JEEP WRANGLER BEARING FL TAG G0CH0. MS. BRITO DUQUE DID STATE THERE WAS A POSSIBILITY SHE LEFT HER VEHICLE UNLOCKED THE EVENING PRIOR.

MR. KHOURY WAS ARRESTED AND TRANSPORTED TO DOCTORS HOSPITAL FOR FURTHER PHYSICAL EVALUATION. DETECTIVE FERNANDEZ (ID # 8376) RESPONDED TO DOCTORS HOSPITAL, WHERE HE WAS ABLE TO INTERVIEW AND READ POST-MIRANDA WARNING TO THE DEFENDANT. MR. KHOURY CONFESSED TO COMMITTING THE LISTED VEHICLE BURGLARY. MR. KHOURY WAS TRANSPORTED TO TGK VIA CGPD PROCESSING.

On Monday, November 9th, 2020, at approximately 0641 hours, I responded in emergency mode to the area of the 400-Block of Zamora Av, in reference to a report of an unknown subject seen breaking into a black Jeep vehicle. The reporter further advised CGPD communications that the subject was still inside the vehicle. Upon my arrival, Officer Crespo had Mr. Alexander William Khoury (Offender) at gun point as the offender exited the black Jeep (FL tag G0CH0) parked in the driveway of the residence of 421 Zamora. He was wearing all black clothing and was holding a black umbrella. I exited my vehicle and heard Officer Crespo give loud and clear commands to the offender to stop and get on the ground.

The offender did not comply and proceeded to walk away from Officer Crespo in an easterly direction and stated "Why do I need to stop." As I approached the offender and gave him loud and clear commands to stop, he proceeded to run in an easterly direction on the 400-blk of Zamora Avenue away from Officer Crespo and myself. Officer Crespo and I engaged in a foot pursuit in attempt to apprehend the offender. Officer Crespo and I ran parallel to each other as we ran after the offender. Officer Crespo was running on my right side as we both continued a foot pursuit. The offender continued to run eastbound along the 400-Block of Zamora Av on the south side sidewalk, as we continued to give the offender loud commands to stop. The offender did not stop and kept running. Prior to reaching Lejeune Rd, I drew my department issued Taser 7 and deployed one cartridge while running and aiming at the offender's mid back area. The deployment had a negative affect and did not fully incapacitate the offender. The offender continued to run and resist arrest. Shortly after the first deployment, I deployed a second Taser cartridge along the 400-Block of Zamora Av, while running and aiming at the offender's mid back area. The second deployment also had a negative affect and did not fully incapacitate the offender.

The offender continued to run in an eastbound direction and crossed Lejeune Rd as we continued to run after him. The offender ran onto the east side sidewalk and stumbled on the southwest grass area of 4138 SW 16 Terrace (Havana Air). As the offender was in a prone position, I approached the right side of the offender and placed my right shin onto his right shoulder blade, while Officer Crespo was on the offender's left side. We attempted to place him in restraints. The offender placed his arms under his chest area and braced tightly while we attempted to pull his arms free. The offender would not free them. Without further incident, we were able to gain control of the offender's arms and place him into custody. The offender was quickly placed in a recovery position. Coral Gables Fire Rescue responded to the scene and treated the offender. Sgt. J. Rodriguez was notified of the incident and responded to the scene.

I met with the victim at 421 Zamora and showed her the umbrella that the offender had in his custody. She confirmed it belonged to her and was taken from her vehicle.
