RESOLUTION NO. 2010-32

RESOLUTION AMENDING CITY'S FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 ANNUAL BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE 2007 AND 2008 URBAN AREAS SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) SUB AWARD GRANTS.

WHEREAS, this resolution amends Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Annual Budget and authorizes an appropriation of funds in the amount of seven hundred and thirty-three thousand four hundred and fourteen dollars (\$733,414.00) for the 2007 and 2008 UASI Grants; and

WHEREAS, the City received approval for the 2007 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant in the amount of five hundred and nineteen thousand two hundred and fifty-nine dollars (\$519,259.00); and

WHEREAS, the City received approval for the 2008 UASI Grant for 2008 in the amount of two hundred and fourteen thousand one hundred and fifty-five dollars (\$214,155.00); and

WHEREAS, these grants are reimbursable for funds expended on Homeland Security Initiatives to prevent, respond and recover from threats or acts of terrorism, with no City matching fund requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby amend the City's Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Annual Budget and authorize the appropriation of funds in the amount of seven hundred and thirty-three thousand four hundred and fourteen dollars (\$733,414.00) for the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Sub Award Grant.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
