RESOLUTION INSTRUCTING CITY STAFF TO LOOK INTO FURTHER FUNDING MECHANISMS FOR THE MIRACLE MILE STREETSCAPE PROJECT, INCLUDING AN ANALYSIS OF THE IMPACT OF INCREASING PARKING FEES BY 25 PERCENT THROUGHOUT THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT AND WHAT THE IMPACT WOULD BE BY COMPARING IT TO OTHER CITIES SIMILAR TO OUR DOWNTOWN DISTRICT THROUGHOUT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission does hereby instruct City Staff to look into further funding mechanisms for the Miracle Mile Streetscape Project, including an analysis of the impact of increasing parking fees by 25 percent throughout the central business district and what the impact would be by comparing it to other cities similar to our downtown district throughout Miami-Dade County.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
