are in violation of the following sections of the City Code of the City of Coral Gables:

Defacement of trees, shrubs, vines, etc. - Sec. 82-3 - Defacement of trees, shrubs, vines, etc. in public places prohibited without permit. (a) Violations of this section shall be punished as provided in section 1-7. (b) No person shall, without a written permit from the city manager and director of public service, cut, prune, break, incline, injure, remove or in any other way deface any living tree, shrub, orchid, or vine, in a public street, city right-of-way, or park, or cut, disturb or interfere in any way with the roots of any tree, shrub, orchid, or vine in a public street, city right-of-way, or park. (Code 1958, § 34-1; Code 1991, § 27-1; Code 2006, § 82-1; Ord. No. 8, § 1, 8-3-1925; Ord. No. 2014-12, § 2, 5-27-2014)

Code Enforcement Officer Comments: Cut down a Black Olive tree on right of way without a permit
