RESOLUTION NO. 2010-247

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SIX (6) MONTH EXTENSION TO ALLOW THE GOODWILL ATTENDED DONATION CENTER TRAILER TO REMAIN ON THE CITY'S PARKING LOT NO. 43, ALONG THE 5900 BLOCK OF PONCE DE LEON BOULEVARD, CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Goodwill South Florida, Inc. has requested an extension to allow the Goodwill Attended Donation Center Trailer to remain an additional six (6) months on the City's Parking Lot No. 43 along the 5900 block of Ponce de Leon Boulevard, Coral Gables, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Goodwill South Florida, Inc. mission is to provide vocational rehabilitation training and employment for people with severe disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Goodwill South Florida, Inc. has operated the temporary attended donation trailer without complaints; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has expressed their desire to continue to allow the Goodwill South Florida, Inc. to serve the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby grant a six-month extension to Goodwill Industries of South Florida, Inc., for temporary placement of a Goodwill Attended Donation Center trailer on Parking Lot 43, along 5900 Ponce de Leon Boulevard, to receive donations.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
