RESOLUTION NO. 2010-27

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN ACCOUNTING TREATMENT FOR USE OF FUNDS IN THE STORMWATER UTILITY FUND; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City maintains a cash and cash equivalent balance in the Stormwater Utility Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to prescribe the purposes and uses of said funds and to provide for the appropriate accounting treatment for effectuation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing ‘Whereas’ clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution upon adoption hereof.


SECTION 2. That the City Commission does hereby establish the following accounting treatment regarding certain Stormwater Utility Fund transfers: That the Stormwater Utility Fund transfers set forth herein shall be evidenced by a transfer from the Stormwater Utility Fund Cash and Cash Equivalent account to the General Fund Cash and Cash Equivalent account as of September 30th of each fiscal year; that such transfer shall be entered for accounting purposes to the extent that sufficient funds are available in the Stormwater Utility Fund accounts as of September 30th of each fiscal year, up to but not exceeding the account balance in the Stormwater Utility Fund not appropriated for other uses to the extent non-appropriated funds in the Stormwater Utility Fund account as of September 30th of any given fiscal year are not sufficient to fully effect the required transfer for that fiscal year, and that any transfer balance remaining should be carried over to subsequent fiscal years until such transfer has been fully accounted for.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission does hereby authorize the transfer from the Stormwater Utility Fund for the following lawful purposes; the recognition and utilization of a reasonable return from the operation of the Stormwater Utility Fund; further stating that said return is established at a rate of ten percent (10%) per year of the operating revenue.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption and shall be applied as of the Fiscal Year 2007-2008.
