Ordinance on Second Reading.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING PATRIOT DAY AS AN OFFICIAL CITY DAY OF REMEMBRANCE AND AMENDING CHAPTER 1, "GENERAL PROVISIONS", SECTION 1-2, "DEFINITIONS AND RULES OF CONSTRUCTION" OF THE CITY CODE TO DESIGNATE PATRIOT DAY AS AN OFFICIAL CITY HOLIDAY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, CODIFICATION, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

September 11th was recognized by the United States House of Representatives as a national day of mourning on October 25, 2001. In a joint resolution approved December 18, 2001, the United States Congress designated September 11th of each year as "Patriot Day," and in 2009, Congress requested the observance of September 11th as an annually recognized "National Day of Service and Remembrance;" in remembrance of the attacks on September 11th, 2001. In remembrance of the terrorist attack of September 11th and in recognition of the lives lost that day, the City Commission wishes to designate Patriot Day as an official day of remembrance and include Patriot Day as an official City Holiday in the City Code.

This item was adopted on first reading during the September 10, 2024 City Commission meeting. There have been no changes since first reading.
