# Ordinance on Second Reading.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING **PATRIOT** DAY OFFICIAL CITY DAY OF REMEMBRANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, "GENERAL PROVISIONS", **SECTION** 1-2. "DEFINITIONS AND CONSTRUCTION" OF THE CITY CODE TO DESIGNATE PATRIOT DAY AS AN OFFICIAL CITY HOLIDAY: **PROVIDING FOR** SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, CODIFICATION, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE **DATE**

## **BRIEF HISTORY:**

September 11<sup>th</sup> was recognized by the United States House of Representatives as a national day of mourning on October 25, 2001. In a joint resolution approved December 18, 2001, the United States Congress designated September 11<sup>th</sup> of each year as "Patriot Day," and in 2009, Congress requested the observance of September 11<sup>th</sup> as an annually recognized "National Day of Service and Remembrance;" in remembrance of the attacks on September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2001. In remembrance of the terrorist attack of September 11<sup>th</sup> and in recognition of the lives lost that day, the City Commission wishes to designate Patriot Day as an official day of remembrance and include Patriot Day as an official City Holiday in the City Code.

This item was adopted on first reading during the September 10, 2024 City Commission meeting. There have been no changes since first reading.
