A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF DIEGON, LLC., AS BEING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID, IN THE SUM OF \$117,193.66, FOR THE INTERIOR REFURBISHMENT OF THE FIRST FLOOR MEN'S LOCKER ROOMS AT THE CENTRAL POLICE STATION, 2801 SALZEDO STREET, CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

WHEREAS, the following bids were opened on April 10, 2008, for the interior refurbishment of the first floor men's locker rooms at the Central Police Station, 2801 Salzedo Street, Coral Gables, Florida:

Design Build, Int.	\$142,355.00
T & G Constructors	\$182,000.00
Gavarrete, Inc.	\$188,900.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the bid of Diegon, LLC. for the interior refurbishment of the first floor men's locker rooms at the Central Police Station, 2801 Salzedo Street, Gables, Florida, in the sum of \$117,193.66, having been recommended by the City's Consultant FGSS Architects, Inc. and the Public Works Department as being the lowest and most responsive bid from among the bids opened on April 10, 2008, as hereinafter set forth, said bid is hereby accepted.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager does hereby direct the Finance Director to allocate the necessary funds and to charge this project to the Capital Improvements Fund.
