CITY COMMISSION MEETING
September 23, 2008**

ITEM TITLE:

An Ordinance of the City Commission of Coral Gables amending the text of Chapter 74 of the City Code Entitled "Traffic and Vehicles", by amending Section 74-356 entitled "Six-Month Notice; Introductory Period", to change the courtesy notice provision from six months to ninety-days; providing a repealer provision; a savings clause; a severability clause, and providing for an effective date.

BRIEF HISTORY:

That Section 74-356 of the "Code of the City of Coral Gables" entitled "Six-Month Notice; Introductory Period", shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 74-356. Ninety-Day Notice; Introductory Period.

For the first ninety days of this article, unless the driver of a vehicle received a citation from a police officer in accordance with normal traffic enforcement techniques, the vehicle owner shall receive a courtesy notice of the violation. Commencing ninety-days after the effective date of the article, the vehicle owner is subject to the enforcement provision as provided herein.
