

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES  
SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD REQUESTING  
THAT THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
CORAL GABLES CONSIDER ADOPTING A  
RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE ENERGY  
INNOVATION AND CARBON DIVIDEND ACT OF  
2019, H.R. 763.

**WHEREAS**, The Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act of 2019, H.R. 763 was introduced by Representative Theodore E. Deutch (D-FL-22) to the 116<sup>th</sup> Congress in January of 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the bill imposes a fee on the carbon content of fuels, including crude oil, natural gas, coal, or any other product derived from those fuels that will be used so as to emit greenhouse gases into the atmosphere; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 18, 2020 the City of Coral Gables Sustainability Advisory Board met and a motion was made to request the City Commission move forward and consider passing a resolution in support of H.R. 763, and the motion was unanimously approved.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD:**

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City of Coral Gables Sustainability Advisory Board requests that the City Commission consider adopting a resolution in support of The Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act, H.R. 763.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
