**Report on Annexation Steps for Little Gables**

- August: Complete gathering of support petitions from minimum 20% of voters,
- October: Staff report to the City Commission including updated feasibility study and voter petition results
- October: Public notice mail-out for City hearing to all Little Gables property owners and to those property owners that live 600 feet outside the boundaries of the annexation area
- October: City Commission hearing to consider official annexation resolution for submittal of annexation application to Miami-Dade County
- Within two weeks of approval of the City Commission annexation resolution, complete preparation of County annexation application
- File annexation application with the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners, and submit petitions for support to the County Department of Elections
- Clerk of the Board schedules the annexation request on an ensuing agenda of a meeting before the County Commission
- Meeting before County Commission to refer annexation request to County Planning Advisory Board for recommendation
- County Planning Advisory Board public hearing with mailed notice to property owners within Little Gables and 600 feet outside the boundaries of Little Gables for a recommendation to the County Commission on the annexation
- County Commission Committee meeting and recommendation on resolution whether to direct County Attorney to prepare annexation ordinance
- County Commission meeting to adopt resolution directing County Attorney to prepare appropriate annexation ordinance

- Board of County Commissioners hearing – first reading and approval of annexation ordinance
- Preparation of Interlocal Agreement between Miami-Dade County and City of Coral Gables subject to an election
- Approval by Coral Gables of interlocal agreement
- Public Hearing before County Commission Committee whether to approve annexation ordinance and resolution adopting interlocal agreement both subject to an election.
- County Commission hearing – second reading and adoption of annexation ordinance and resolution adopting interlocal agreement, all subject to an election and directing that election be conducted
- Election conducted on annexation question by County Elections Department, typically a mailed ballot election
- County Execution of Interlocal Agreement between the County and Coral Gables
