RESOLUTION NO. 2020-216

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION DIRECTING THAT THE SEPTEMBER 22, 2020 CITY COMMISSION MEETING AND SECOND BUDGET MEETING BE HELD IN A HYBRID FORMAT, WITH THE PUBLIC ATTENDING VIRTALLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE ADOPTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION, AND THAT STARTING OCTOBER 13, 2020, COMMISSION MEETINGS BE HELD IN THE TRADITIONAL FORMAT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE ADOPTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the Governor of the State of Florida issued Executive Order No. 20-52, declaring a state of emergency for the entire State of Florida and said order was issued in response to the Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention has advised that in order to slow the spread of the Coronavirus/COVID-19, individuals should adopt far-reaching social distancing measures; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with all applicable orders and rules, and after adopting Rules of Procedure, the City Commission has met in a fully-virtual format since March 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to have the September 22, 2020 City Commission meeting and the Second Budget Meeting in a hybrid format with the public attending virtually, in accordance with the Rules of Procedures adopted by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to resume traditional in-person meetings beginning with the October 13, 2020 City Commission meeting, in accordance with the Rules of Procedure adopted by the City Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission directs that the September 22, 2020 City Commission meeting and the Second Budget Meeting be held in a hybrid format in accordance with the Rules of Procedure adopted by the City Commission.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission directs that beginning October 13, 2020, City Commission meetings resume in a traditional in-person format, in accordance with the Rules of Procedure adopted by the City Commission.

SECTION 4. That said Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
