**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-242**

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE / 1033 PROGRAM TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF ONE MINE RESISTANT AMBUSH PROTECTED VEHICLE FROM THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES POLICE DEPARTMENT TO THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coral Gables Police Department acquired a Mine Resistant Ambush Protected vehicle from the Law Enforcement Support Office / 1033 Program in April 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 30, 2016, the Coral Gables Police Department received approval from the Law Enforcement Support Office / 1033 Program to transfer ownership of the acquired MRAP to the City of Miami Beach Police Department;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SWCTION 1.** The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission accepts the Law Enforcement Support Office / 1033 Program transfer of ownership of one Mine Resistant Ambush Protected vehicle from the City of Coral Gables Police Department to the City of Miami Beach Police Department.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein




