RESOLUTION 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, RECOGNIZING THE CITY'S LONGSTANDING RELATIONSHIP WITH THE GRANADA GOLF ASSOCIATION, INC., GREENWAY WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION, INC., AND THE CORAL GABLES WOMEN'S GOLF AND BRIDGE ASSOCIATION, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUED ADMINISTRATIVE RESERVATION OF CERTAIN TEE TIMES BLOCKS FOR EXISTING MEMBERS OF SUCH ASSOCIATIONS, SUBJECT TO APPLICABLE LEGAL, OPERATIONAL, AND FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE CITY; AND DIRECTING STAFF TO WORK WITH THE EXISTING ASSOCIATIONS UNDER THOSE CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates the historic Granada Golf Course as a public golf facility intended to serve residents and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Granada Golf Association, Inc., Greenway Women's Golf Association, Inc., and Coral Gables Women's Golf and Bridge Association, Inc. are all non-profits in South Florida dedicated to promoting participation in golf; and

WHEREAS, all three organizations have served the community for decades, Granada Golf Association for over sixty years, Greenway Women's Golf Association for over sixty years, and the Coral Gables Women's Golf and Bridge Association for over ninety years; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the community value and historical presence of these associations, while also acknowledging the need to ensure that their continued use of the facility is aligned with the City's operational, legal, and financial requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission affirms that all tee time allocations at the Granada Golf Course shall remain under the direction and control of City staff, who shall work with the Granada Golf Association, Inc., Greenway Women's Golf Association, Inc., and the Coral Gables Women's Golf and Bridge Association, Inc. regarding the continued setting aside of certain tee times, and such allocations shall be managed in a manner that balances association use with public access, course capacity, and operational needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. That the foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution

upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission hereby formally recognizes the City's ongoing relationship with the Granada Golf Association, Inc., Greenway Women's Golf Association, Inc., and the Coral Gables Women's Golf and Bridge Association, Inc.

SECTION 3. That City Staff is directed to work with the above-referenced associations and existing members for continued use of the Granada Golf Course, subject to compliance with the City's legal, operational, and financial requirements.

SECTION 4. That City Staff shall provide for the continued setting aside of a similar quantity and times of tee times for members of the referenced associations; however, all tee time allocations shall be established, administered, and adjusted at the sole direction of the City Manager or designee, based on course capacity, seasonal demand, operational conditions, and public access priorities, and shall not create any exclusive or vested rights.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
