





IMPLEMENTATION – COST

ALL COST ARE BASED ON 2019 ESTIMATES WITH NO ESCALATION COST APPLIED

• **Option I (Minimal Intervention) -** \$3.2 million

- Detached bump outs
- Improved landscaping
- Lighting Improvements

• **Option II (Permanent Rebuild) -** \$7.0 million

- Full pavement reconstruction
- Improved Landscaping
- Lighting Improvements
- Drainage Improvements

• **Option III (Change of Character) -** \$3.7 million

- Replacement of parking lanes with swales
- Improved landscaping
- Lighting Improvements


