RESOLUTION NO. 2008-01

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000.00 FROM THE TENET HEALTH CARE FOUNDATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE CORAL GABLES POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS UPGRADE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Tenet Health Care Foundation Grant Program offers grant awards to give back needed services within the communities surrounding their facilities; and

WHEREAS, Coral Gables Hospital is a Tenet Health Care Facility and the Coral Gables Police Department applied to the grant program for their Automatic External Defibrillator Upgrade Project; and

WHEREAS, On October 29, 2007, the Tenet Health Care Foundation notified the Coral Gables Police Department that an award of \$10,000.00 had been approved for this project; and

WHEREAS, this award will allow the Coral Gables Police Department to purchase six biphasic Automatic External Defibrillators for police officers who provide first responder assistance to sick and injured persons;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City of Coral Gables and the Coral Gables Police Department accepts the generous award of \$10,000.00 from the Tenet Health Care Foundation Grant Program for the Automatic External Defibrillator Upgrade Project.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


