A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000 TO AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC. TO ALLOW THE CONTINUATION OF OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE SERVICES FOR THE MIRACLE MILE AND GIRALDA AVENUE STREETScape PROJECT.

**WHEREAS**, the Miracle Mile and Giralda Avenue Streetscape project is the result of Community visioning; and

**WHEREAS**, this project includes the transformation of the public realm to create a civic promenade that will become a focal point for the region; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 9, 2016 the City of Coral Gables entered into an Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. to provide professional services under a continuing service contract; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 20, 2016 the City of Coral Gables entered into an Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. for the purpose of providing Owner's Representative Services for the Streetscape project; and

**WHEREAS**, the scope of services provides an AECOM staff person serving as the liaison between the City, the CMAR firm (Ric-Man International), and the Consultant (Cooper Robertson), and their Sub-consultants; and

**WHEREAS**, this change order provides for the continuation of such services through the completion of the project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption.

**SECTION 2.** That the change order in the amount of \$200,000 to AECOM Technical Services to allow the continuation of Owner's Representative Services for the Miracle Mile and Giralda Avenue Streetscape Project.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
