- B. The City may waive one or more of the enumerated charges for nonprofit organizations based upon experience with previous events, size, duration, location, nature of the event and the likelihood of un-removed litter or damage to property. In the event that the nonprofit organization demonstrates that it has contracted for clean-up activities with a city-approved group, the performance bond shall be waived.
- C. Neighborhood or block parties shall be exempt from the provisions of this article so long as no commercial activity is conducted, no admission fee is charged, and members of the general public are not allowed access. Provided, however, that individuals or organizations should notify the City Manager's Office when a neighborhood party is planned so that police, fire, and other emergency service organizations will be aware of the time, place, and scope of the event.
- D. The closing fee set forth in this article shall be construed as being in addition to other fees or charges imposed for labor, materials, police or fire protection services, or any other charges for City services incidental to the assembly or street closing and other fees shall still be levied and collected in addition to the closing fee herein provided.
- E. Political or public issue events shall be exempt from the provisions of this Section. Individuals or organizations planning such an event shall notify the City Manager's Office when a political or public issue event is planned so that police, fire, and other emergency service organizations will be aware of the time, place, and scope of the event and the name or names of persons in charge.
- F. Funeral processions shall be exempt from the terms of this article.
- G. ADA Notice: The City welcomes individuals with disabilities. To request a modification to a policy, practice or procedure or to request an auxiliary aide or service (such as a sign language interpreter) in order to participate in a City program, activity or event, please contact the City's ADA Coordinator Dona Spain or the Director of the sponsoring department at least three (3) business days in advance. ADA Coordinator Dona Spain may be reached by email: dspain@coralgables.com, or by telephone: 305-460-5095 (voice) or 305-460-5010 (TTY/TDD).
- H. All Expanded Polystyrene (Styrofoam) containers is prohibited. Special events permittees and their subcontractors are prohibited from selling, using or providing food/drinks in, or offering the use of, expanded polystyrene articles. Upon warning, the permittee or subcontractor must discontinue use. Failure to do so within a reasonable amount of time may lead to the discontinuation of the service, sale or participation in the event. Violations may also lead to the imposition of fines, the revocation of the permit, the placement of conditions on future special events permits or the denial of future special events permits. The Permit Applicant jointly and severally, hereby hold harmless, indemnify and defend the City of Coral Gables, its representatives, officers, agents, affiliates, employees, the administration and elected and appointed officials from and against all liability, suits, actions, claims, costs, expenses or demands (including, without limitation, suits, actions, claims, costs, expenses or demands resulting from death, personal injury and property damage) or expenses of every kind and character, including reasonable attorney's fees, costs and appeals, arising or resulting in whole or in part, as a result of any tort, intentional action, negligent acts or omissions on the part of the Permit Applicant or any of the participants of the Event outlined in this application. This indemnification provision shall survive the termination of this contract and shall be in full force and effect beyond the term or termination of this contract, however, terminated. This indemnification provision includes claims made by the entitlement, if any, to immunity under section 440.11, Florida Statutes. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a waiver of any immunity or limitation of liability the City may have under the doctrine of sovereign immunity of section §768.28, Florida Statutes.
