Problem Identification

The Coral Gables Police Department recognizes the importance of officer safety and community safety in its mission of providing police services. Our Traffic Enforcement Unit strives to maintain control of traffic matters through the enforcement of traffic laws within the City of Coral Gables. During the course of their duties, the members of this unit must often enter a traffic intersection. If the officer is not properly visible when breaching the intersection, there presents a safety issue for both the officer on the motorcycle and the civilians in vehicles.

This grant will enable our Department to purchase much needed motorcycle saddlebag emergency lighting equipment. This equipment will allow officers to be seen when breaching an intersection, thus protecting the officers, as well as residents and visitors to our community.

Project Summary (Scope of Work)

The Coral Gables Police Department intends to use fiscal year 2017 JAG C grant funds to purchase law enforcement equipment for its Traffic Enforcement Unit. This equipment consists of side emergency lights for the 11 motorcycles used by the Traffic Enforcement Unit.

The emergency lights to be purchased are specifically made for the Harley Davidson Police motorcycles currently in use by our Department. The lights are built to fit in between the saddlebag guards of the motorcycles and come in red/blue, red/red, blue/blue and also a combination of the three colors. These LED lights are highly visible when an officer breaches an intersection as well as when the officer is facing perpendicular to a vehicle. Currently our motorcycles do not have any emergency lights near the saddlebag, and with the motorcycle being black it is difficult for officers to be seen, particularly when it is dark out. These lights increase the safety of our Unit officers when out in the field and will assist in decreasing the risk of accidents during the course of duty.

Upon approval of this grant application and subsequent approval by our governing body, the purchase of this equipment will be initiated by quotes provided by vendors. The equipment will be selected per the Procurement Code and a requisition will be submitted to the selected vendor. The approval of the requisition will generate a purchase order to be provided to the vendor. Upon receipt of the equipment, invoices will be obtained in order to indicate receipt of all items and to initiate payment by means of a check to the vendor. The City receives proof of payment through cancelled checks.
