ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2018-272 TO NAME THE CITY OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2665 DE SOTO BOULEVARD, CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA 33134 "LAMAR LOUISE CURRY PARK" FOR A MINIMUM PERIOD OF 25 YEARS AND PROVIDING FOR A FINANCIAL PENALTY SHOULD THE NAME OR THE USE OF THE PROPERTY BE CHANGED IN THAT TIME PERIOD (Sponsored by Commissioner Keon)

BRIEF HISTORY:

In Resolution No. 2018-272 the City named the City owned property located at 2665 De Soto Boulevard "The Lamar Louise Curry Park." Subsequently, in 2019, the City Commission authorized the acceptance of a donation of \$200,000 dollars from the Coral Gables Garden Club on behalf of the Miss Lamar Louise Curry Trust. The City is using those funds, along with an additional \$175,000 budgeted by the City for improvements to the Lamar Louise Curry Park. The Coral Gables Garden Club has requested that the park retain the name "Lamar Louise Curry Park" for a minimum of twenty-five years, and should the name of use of the park change in that time period, that a prorated amount of the donation be returned to the Coral Gables Garden Club.

This proposed resolution removes the "the" from the name of the "Lamar Louise Curry Park" and sets forth that the name shall be retained for a minimum of twenty-five years. Should the name of use of the property be changed in that time period, the City will return a prorated amount of the \$200,000 donation.
