




PHILLIPS PARK - EXISTING CONDITIONS



PHILLIPS PARK PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Expansion and relocation of the playground to provide for a larger more active playground area.
- Removal of one tennis court and relocation of basketball court to provide a proper fenced-in court.
- Resurfacing and new hardscapes and equipment for both tennis and basketball courts.
- · Wider multi-use walkways with new concrete surfacing.
- New landscaping, perimeter fencing, and park furnishings.
- Shade structure designs for splash pad and play area.

PHILLIPS PARK ESTIMATED COST & WHAT'S NEXT

- Total estimated project budget: \$9,500,000.
 - Phase I project budget currently available: \$3,000,000.
 - Full funding available: October 2024 (FY 25).
 - Projected grant budget: \$400,000.
 - \$200,000 grant award and \$200,000 city match.
- Grant application submitted: 8-30-22.
- Awarded state grant funding cycle for 2023-2024 budget year by July 2024 with a 3-year completion deadline from award date.

- · We are here: Completed initial project concept meetings with the neighboring community, advisory boards and community associations to receive support in the pursuit of grant funding for this park project.
- Scheduled to meet with affected school groups (PTSA/PTA).
- Retained an architect to provide an updated concept design and project cost estimate to receive input from advisory boards and the community.
- Proposed follow-up community meeting: May 2023.
- Permitting & procurement for construction: 2024.
- Estimated construction timeline: 16 months.
