

City of Coral Gables CITY COMMISSION MEETING January 8, 2019

ITEM TITLE:

A Resolution of the City Commission accepting the City Clerk's Certification and Declaration of Results from the Retirement Board Elections, (December 4th through December 7, 2018), thereby confirming the re-election of Troy Easley, who ran unopposed, to the City of Coral Gables Retirement Board, Firefighter Employee Representative seat, for a term beginning January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2020; and Cesar Canas, to the Coral Gables Retirement Board Participating Regular Full-time (General/Teamster) Employee Representative seat for a term beginning January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2020.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION:

The City Clerk recommends approval of the aforementioned Resolution.

BRIEF HISTORY:

On November 1, 2018, Nominating Petitions forms were emailed to all departments for posting regarding the upcoming Retirement Board election for a Firefighter Employee Representative seat and a Participating Regular Full-time (General/Teamster) Employee Representative seat; both terms beginning January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2020 with a deadline for submittal of said forms of November 19, 2018 at 5 p.m.

At the close of the business day on November 19, 2018, at 5 p.m., the City Clerk's Office only received a Nominating Petition form and Acceptance Letter for Troy Easley (Firefighter Representative Seat); thereby winning by being unopposed. For the nomination of (Participating Full-Time (General/Teamster) Employee Representative seat, Cesar Canas and Jesus Cordero submitted a Nominating Petition form and Acceptance Letter each.

On Friday, December 7, 2018 at 5 p.m., the close of the electronic election voting, Cesar Canas was determined the winner of the Participating Regular Full-time (General/Teamster) Employee seat.
