OF FIVE (5) 3' X 3 ½' BANNERS AT CERTAIN CITY
FACILITIES FROM OCTOBER 23 THROUGH OCTOBER 31,
2009, IN RECOGNITION OF "RED RIBBON CAMPAIGN
WEEK IN THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES"**

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon week is scheduled this year for the week of October 23, 2009 through October 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon Campaign has a tradition of displaying red ribbons as a symbol of intolerance towards the use of drugs; and

WHEREAS, the Red Ribbon week is a way for communities to take a visible stand against drugs through the symbol of the Red Ribbon.
