A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, COMMITTING TO ACHIEVING VISION ZERO, ZERO ROADWAY FATALITIES, BY 2030.
(SPONSORED BY VICE MAYOR ANDERSON)

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City of Coral Gables has experienced an uptick in roadway fatalities. In the first quarter of 2024, the city has endured as many deaths as any of the prior seven years. Further, both nationwide and in Florida, accidents and fatalities have significantly increased for vulnerable road users like pedestrians, bicyclists, wheelchair users, and others.

To address the dangers inherent to roadways, many communities across the nation and worldwide have committed to eradicating roadway fatalities by adopting the Vision Zero program. This program creates safer roads through a holistic, systematic approach focused on safer people, safer roads, safer vehicles, safer speeds, and post-crash care.
