BUILDING OFFICIAL'S RECOMMENDATION: A. Submit an updated letter from a structural Engineer within seven (7) days of the Board's meeting attesting the structure is safe for occupancy. B. Submit a Revised Recertification Report prepared by a licensed Architect or Engineer within sixty (60) days of the Board's Order Recertifying the property. C. A \$250 daily fine be imposed, if any of these deadlines are not met.
