Update regarding Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Coral Gables and Miami-Dade County Public Schools for police coverage at local schools.

Mayor Valdes-Fauli: I-2 – Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Coral Gables and Miami-Dade County Public Schools for police coverage at local schools.

Chief Hudak: Yes sir. On the item – these have been adjusted back, the reimbursable to the City to the tune of \$70,000 per school. We have incorporated because of the Marjory Stoneman Douglas Act, a requirement to handle charter schools. We are doing that with an off-duty officer that the charter school is paying for. We did give up ESPA and we still continue to patrol West Lab school on an overtime situation. Those monies have been put into the accounts that we will be covering to make sure. One of the clarifications that came up in the School Board was that an officer does have to be physically on the premises from bell to bell. Any officers that are working in an off-duty capacity cannot give that away and it cannot be left unattended at all. So, there will be some
