#### **SUBMISSIONS CRITERIA:**

- Property must be within the City of Coral Gables limits
- Has not previously been awarded a garden award in the past 5 years
- Does not have any zoning violations
- Utilizes garden materials

#### **JUDGING CRITERIA:**

- Exhibits lushness, garden, and beauty
- Stands out as a planned/designed space that blends color and details together
- Enhances the community through distinctly tropical planting
- Is ecologically conscious / sensitive
- Provides shade, seating, or other landscape-based amenities for residents through its design
- Enhances the quality of life for citizens in Coral Gables




