## CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH WATERWAYS HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATIONS ADVISORY BOARD RECOMMENDING THAT THE CITY COMMISSION AMEND SECTION 38-11 OF THE CITY CODE.

**WHEREAS,** Section 38-11 of the City Code requires drivers wishing to enter an area of the City serviced by a guardhouse to roll their windows down between the hours of 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. upon the request of guardhouse personnel; and

**WHEREAS,** Coral Gables homeowners' associations responsible for areas serviced by guardhouses have voiced concerns that requiring drivers to roll down their windows during a certain set of hours is insufficient to safeguard said communities because vehicles enter said areas at various times of day with illegally tinted windows; and

**WHEREAS,** car thefts and other neighborhood crimes have occurred prior to the prescribed hours of inspection; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 14, acknowledging their residents' concerns, the South Waterways Homeowners' Associations Advisory Board voted to recommend to the City Commission to amend Section 38-11 of the City Code to indefinitely extend the hours during which guardhouse personnel may ask drivers to roll down their windows.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the South Waterways Homeowners' Associations Advisory Board recommends that the City Commission amend Section 38-11 of the City Code to require drivers wishing to enter areas serviced by a guardhouse to roll down their windows at any time of day upon the request of the guardhouse personnel.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
