RESOLUTION NO. 2010_____

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE CONTRACT LIMIT WITH METRO EXPRESS, INC. BY \$150,000 FOR FURTHER STREET IMPROVEMENTS, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FINAL CONTRACT PERIOD ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2010.

WHEREAS, in order to meet current obligations to improve traffic conditions and promote pedestrian safety, it will be necessary for the City to increase the contract with its current Street Improvement Contractor, Metro Express, Inc. in the amount of \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, this will increase the total contract amount to \$1,350,000 for the remainder of the final contract period ending on September 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Metro Express, Inc.'s original contract was awarded by the City Commission (Resolution No. 2007-98) on May 22, 2007 in the amount of \$1,200,000 for a one-year period with two (2) one-year renewable options not to exceed \$1,200,000 each; and

WHEREAS, this contract was amended by City Resolution No. 2008-16 on January 22, 2008, by increasing the first year contract limit by \$800,000 for a total amount of \$2,000,000; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, a Purchase Order was issued in the amount of \$2,400,000 to reflect the contract renewals for FY 2009 and FY 2010; and

WHEREAS, the \$150,000 increase in contract limit with Metro Express, Inc. will complete their contract final year for an amount of \$1,350,000 for the three-year period from FY 2008 – FY 2010; and

WHEREAS, this increase in contract amount will allow the completion of various paving, drainage, and traffic calming projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. That an increase in the contract limit with Metro Express, Inc. by \$150,000 for further street improvements, for the remainder of the final contract period ending on September 30, 2010, is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon the date of its adoption and passage herein.
