ITEM TITLE:

An Ordinance of the City Commission of the City of Coral Gables approving the purchase of property at 4650 Alhambra Circle, Coral Gables, Florida, the legal description and folio number which are set forth as follows: folio no. 03-4119-001-0920, Lots 11 to 14 inc., Block 77, Coral Gables Country Club Section 5, PB 23-55 of the public records of Miami-Dade County, Florida for an amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00), pursuant to Ordinance No. 2009-53 which provides the authority and approving any and all appropriate action to accomplish said purpose, providing a repealer provision, a savings clause, and a severability clause, and providing for an effective date.

BRIEF HISTORY:

On July 7th, 2009 the City Commission approved a resolution authorizing the City to apply for and receive a grant from the Miami-Dade Safe Neighborhood Parks program for the purpose of land acquisition for use as a neighborhood park.

The property of 4650 Alhambra Circle was reviewed and selected by staff as the property to apply for the grant funds in the Safe Neighborhood Parks program. The Safe Neighborhood Parks Oversight Committee and the Miami-Dade County Commission awarded the City of Coral Gables \$220,050 towards the purchase of this property. This grant amount, coupled with \$779,950 from the Miami-Dade County General Obligation Bond Project Agreement No. 88-70653 for land acquisition for park use, will be used for the purchase of the property.

The purchase of this property is in accordance with Ordinance No. 2009-53 that established set procedures for the purchase, sale or lease of public lands and buildings. Three appraisals of the property are attached. Also attached are analyses prepared by the Finance, Economic Development, Parking, Public Works, Planning and Historical Preservation Departments as required by that ordinance. Excerpt Minutes from the Budget and Audit Advisory Board, Economic Development Board and Property Advisory Board as required by the ordinance and excerpt minutes from the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board are also attached.

Please note that the 2009 real estate property taxes for this property were \$13,067.16. The maintenance of this property as a passive park will be approximately \$5,000 per year.


