Re: Crime Analyst JULIAN POZO

On any given day Julian Pozo is coordinating with federal, state, and local law enforcement partners – sharing intelligence. He is instrumental in gathering data from a multitude of investigative resources, all to assist investigative units and patrol units.

He has identified trends, forecasted crime, and detected criminal patterns strengthening the Police department's crime prevention efforts.

He has even utilized his skill set to locate at-large offenders on behalf of the Investigative Division. A prime example occurred recently when Julian was able to determine the whereabouts of an offender in real-time by leveraging license plate reader database/technology, which resulted in offender's quick apprehension. It is important to note that the Offender was suffering from mental crisis and was armed with a rifle at the time of apprehension.

Julian is a civilian member of the department's Crisis Negotiation team, he is a certified civilian law enforcement drone pilot, and is at the forefront of the creation of the Department's Real Time Crime Initiative.
