**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-355**

A RESOLUTIONS ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AUTHORIZE PARTICIPATION IN A PIGGYBACK CONTRACT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE PURCHASE OF GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL.

**WHEREAS**, the City has budgeted \$1,800,000 in gasoline and diesel fuel during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year to operate City motor vehicles and equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-978 of the Procurement Code, entitled "*Use of other governmental unit contracts ("piggyback")*", provides that the Commission may approve purchases for supplies and services such as gasoline and diesel fuel in excess of \$600,000 from current contracts of other governmental units, which contracts have resulted from a formal competitive bid process, awarded to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder meeting specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, The Chief Procurement Officer in consultation with the Automotive Department Director has determined that the gasoline and diesel fuel contract from Miami-Dade County will best meet the needs of the City in terms of price and quality of gasoline and diesel fuel offered; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-650 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Commission does hereby direct the City Manager to authorize the Chief Procurement Officer to participate in a piggyback contract with Miami-Dade County for the purchase of gasoline and diesel fuel pursuant to Section 2-978 entitled "*Use of other governmental unit contracts ("piggyback")*", of the Procurement Code.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.


