RESOLUTIONS ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AUTHORIZE PARTICIPATION IN A PIGGYBACK CONTRACT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE PURCHASE OF GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL.

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted \$1,800,000 in gasoline and diesel fuel during the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year to operate City motor vehicles and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-978 of the Procurement Code, provides that the Commission may approve purchases for supplies and services such as gasoline and diesel fuel in excess of \$600,000 from current contracts of other governmental units, which contracts have resulted from a formal competitive bid process, awarded to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder meeting specifications; and

WHEREAS, The Chief Procurement Officer in consultation with the Automotive Department Director has determined that the gasoline and diesel fuel contract from Miami-Dade County will best meet the needs of the City in terms of price and quality of gasoline and diesel fuel offered; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-650 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. That the Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer, authorizing participation in a piggyback contract of Miami-Dade County for the purchase of gasoline and diesel fuel.

Section 3. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with, or in conflict herewith, shall be and are hereby repealed insofar as there is conflict or inconsistency.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
