**ITEM TITLE:**

**RESOLUTION.** A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO DRAFT A PEAFOWL MITIGATION PLAN TO SUBMIT TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RECENTLY ADOPTED COUNTY LEGISLATION (Sponsored by Mayor Lago)

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

In February of 2022, the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 22-14 amending Section 5-16 of the Code of Miami-Dade County to allow municipalities to opt out of regulations relating to peafowl. In order to opt out of the relevant Miami-Dade County Code provision, a municipality must adopt a peafowl mitigation plan that provides for humane removal of peafowl, provided that the plan is also approved by action of the Board of County Commissioners.

The City Commission wishes to empower private property owners to address nuisance peafowl within the City, and directs staff to draft a peafowl mitigation plan that comports with all relevant legislation, including relevant Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission regulations.
