RESOLUTION NO. 2016-72

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STAFF TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROPOSED 2016 STREET RESURFACING INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission acknowledges that maintaining City streets is a significant factor in contributing to the enhancement of the City's neighborhoods and the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, the City paved approximately 30 lane miles identified as in need of resurfacing through the Commission approved Neighborhood Renaissance Program (NRP); and

WHEREAS, the 2016 paving program is funded by the reallocation of NRP funds and will include \$1,000,000 of street resurfacing throughout the City of Coral Gables;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution upon adoption hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Commission does hereby authorize staff to proceed with the implementation of the 2016 street resurfacing initiative.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage and adoption herein.
