## **Accomplishments**

This month Ambassadors put in alot of time and effort into keeping all benches and ballards clean and free of mildew, as heavy rains have caused several benches to look green due to algae growth. The pressure washer was used twice (2x) a week in order to keep up with the work load.

### **Field Observations**


Heavy rains have caused pavers to sink and sand to rise above the pavers. Tree roots are starting to become an issue causing pavers to lift making them a tripping hazard for pedestrians on the Mile. Ambassadors worked on fixing sunken pavers as they become an issue.

#### **Field Observations**

Ambasadors have been doing an extraordinary job at maintaining the Mile clean, even with the inclement weather we have experienced lately. They have had to remove fallen tree branches, excess leaves and debris from drains, they also struggle on a daily basis with dog feces and human feces from the homeless that they encounter on the mile several times throughout the day.










































# **Hospitality Highlights**
