DRAFT RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE **CHIEF** PROCUREMENT OFFICER TO AWARD THE **SUBDIVISION** HAMMOCK LAKE **STREET** RESURFACING IMPROVEMENTS CONTRACT TO H & R PAVING, INC., PURSUANT TO INVITATION FOR BID (IFB) 2014.05.20, AND SECTION 2-828 OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE ENTITLED "CONTRACT AWARD".

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2014, the Procurement Division of Finance formally advertised issued and distributed the Hammock Lake Subdivision Street Resurfacing Improvements IFB 2014.05.20; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2014, a non-mandatory pre-bid conference was held with three (3) prospective bidders in attendance of the eight (8) contractors who obtained the bid package from the Procurement Division of Finance; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2014, six (6) bids were submitted by H&R Paving, Inc., Metro Express, Inc., General Asphalt Company, Inc., JVA Engineering Contractor, Inc., H&J Asphalt, Inc., Rock Power Paving, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive responsible bidder for this contract was determined to be H & R Paving, Inc., with a bid of \$426,085.16; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer pursuant to Section 2-828 of the Procurement Code entitled "Contract Award" and Invitation for Bid (IFB) 2014.05.20 recommends that H & R Paving, Inc., be awarded the Hammock Lake Subdivision Street Resurfacing Improvements; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-650 of the Procurement Code authorizes the City Manager to delegate authority to the Chief Procurement Officer to administer and make recommendations on City contracts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. That the City Commission accepts the recommendation of the Chief Procurement Officer to award the Hammock Lake Subdivision Street Resurfacing Improvements contract to H & R Paving, Inc., pursuant to Invitation For Bid (IFB) 2014.05.20, and Section 2-828 of the Procurement Code entitled "Contract Award", subject to final approval and execution of a contract by City staff.

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Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
