On June 12, 2025, the Historic Preservation Board made the following motion recommending as follows:

Mr. Garcia-Pons made a motion to recommend to the City Commission three priorities to consider for the City Hall windows:

- 1. Protect the building to last another 100 years. Regardless of the solution, this is the most important priority.
- 2. Try to keep the existing 100-year-old windows that are an important character defining element of this Historic Landmark.
- 3. Have the City's consultant architect explore hurricane protection options to maintain the existing windows to achieve priority number one.

Ms. Spain seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
