SUBJECT: 2025 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Application Results


Dear Mayor Lago:

Pursuant to correspondence from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) dated June 17, 2025, and in collaboration with the Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), the selection process for the 2025 Transportation Alternatives (TA) Program application cycle has been successfully concluded (see attached letter). On May 29, 2025, the Miami-Dade TPO Governing Board adopted Resolution #13-2025 approving the attached 2027-2031 TPO List of Priority Projects (LOPP). We are pleased to share that the **City of Coral Gables – Granada Boulevard Sidewalk Improvement Program** has been included in the LOPP, with an allocation of \$950,200 for Design, Construction, and Construction Engineering & Inspection in Fiscal Years (FYs) 2028 & 2030.

Congratulations on the successful inclusion of your project in the program. This recognition reflects the quality of your application and the importance of your proposed improvements to the community. Your project will be included in the FDOT District Six FYs 2027-2031 Tentative Work Program. Following approval of the Tentative Work Program by the Florida Legislature and Governor, the Miami-Dade TPO will incorporate the project in the upcoming FY 2027-2031 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), scheduled for adoption Spring 2026.

We appreciate your dedication and effort invested in preparing your application and presenting the project to FDOT's scoping committee. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to inform you that the selection process for this year's Transportation Alternatives (TA) Cycle has concluded. This process was a collaborative effort between FDOT, and the Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization's (TPO) committees. Please find the attached list of projects that are recommended for programming in FDOT's Tentative Work Program. Projects are programmed dependent on project readiness and funding. Funding is subject to the availability of the federal funds and an annual appropriation by the legislature (the spending authority). PLANNING ORGANIZATION LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS FISCAL
YEAR 2031**

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Agreement creating and establishing the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Miami Urbanized Area requires that the Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), in its role as the MPO, provides a structure to evaluate the adequacy of the transportation planning and programming process; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Planning Council (TPC) has been established as the technical advisory council to the TPO Governing Board; and

WHEREAS, the Annual TPO List of Priority Projects (LOPP), a statutory requirement under F.S. 339.175, contains funding needs for inclusion in the upcoming Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Tentative Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the LOPP document will be utilized by FDOT and other transportation partner agencies for inclusion in their respective transportation plans for the purpose of identifying funding to implement these projects based on anticipated federal, state, and local revenues; and

WHEREAS, the TPC has reviewed the LOPP Fiscal Year 2031, made a part hereof, and finds it consistent with the goals and objectives of the Long Range Transportation Plan for the Miami Urbanized Area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION IN ITS ROLE AS THE MPO FOR THE MIAMI URBANIZED AREA,

Section 1. That the attached Annual Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) List of Priority Projects Fiscal Year 2031 is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the TPO Executive Director is hereby authorized to submit the above referenced document to the appropriate funding agencies for inclusion in their respective transportation plans and to execute all appropriate amendments and non-policy changes as requested by the appropriate funding agencies.
