**A RESOLUTION OF THE CORAL GABLES CITY COMMISSION
DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE A REPORT AND
RECOMMENDATION ON THE ADOPTION OF A LIVING WAGE
ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES**

WHEREAS, minimum wage laws benefit employers and the economy by improving employee performance and reducing employee turnover, thereby improving productivity and the quality of services provided by employees; and

WHEREAS, a living wage ordinance requires employers to pay wages that are above federal or state minimum wage levels; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Coral Gables adopts the philosophy of a living wage ordinance and directs the City Manager to provide a report and recommendation to the City Commission on the adoption thereof;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:

SECTION 1: The foregoing "Whereas" clause are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and is hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to prepare a report and recommendation and present it to the City Commission for its review in December 2008.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
