RESOLUTION NO. 2020-51

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND CITY OF CORAL GABLES FOR THE USE OF THE METRORAIL SOUTH CORRIDOR FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TWO DRIVEWAYS AND INSTALLATION OF A FORCE MAIN AND ELECTRICAL SERVICE FOR FIRE STATION 2/TROLLEY BUILDING.

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2019, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2019-214 which approved an interlocal agreement (“Interlocal Agreement”) with Miami-Dade County (the “County”) which granted to the City of Coral Gables (the “City”) a non-exclusive license, privilege, and right for the construction of two driveways and of a three-inch force main within the County’s land in connection with the Coral Gables Fire and Trolley Station Project (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the location of the egress driveway has changed within the Project and the City and the County have agreed to amend the Interlocal Agreement to indicate the new driveway access within the “License Area,” as provided in the attached Amendment to Interlocal Agency Agreement between Miami -Dade County and City of Coral Gables (the “Amendment”);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:


