A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF S. 2302, "AMERICA'S TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE ACT OF 2019" (Sponsored by Vice Mayor Lago)

**BRIEF HISTORY:**

The City of Coral Gables has long supported infrastructure for electric and alternative fuel vehicles, including the recent passage of certain requirements for electric vehicle charging stations. The City is proud to have the largest municipal fleet of electric vehicles in the state of Florida.

S. 2302, "America's Transportation Infrastructure Act of 2019" was introduced to the United States Senate by Senator John Barrasso [R-WV], and would, among other things, establish a grant program for states and localities to build infrastructure for electric, natural gas, and hydrogen-powered vehicles along designated highways, and would create a working group to encourage certain Federal agencies to transition vehicle fleets to hybrid-electric, electric, and alternative fuel vehicles to the maximum extent practicable.

As such, the City of Coral Gables City Commission states its support for America's Transportation Infrastructure Act of 2019.
