



The following is added to Paragraph 8. #### **AUTO EXTRA ENDORSEMENT**

This endorsement modifies insurance provided under the following:

BUSINESS AUTO COVERAGE FORM COMMON POLICY CONDITIONS

Any legally incorporated business entity organized under the laws of the United States of America (including any state thereof, its territories or possessions), or Canada (including any province thereof) will qualify as a Named Insured if there is no similar insurance available to that organization, provided that one or more Named Insureds shown in the Declarations have, at the inception of the policy period, an ownership interest in such organization of more than 50%. N. UNINTENTIONAL FAILURE TO DISCLOSE HAZARDS

The following Paragraph is added to SECTION IV – BUSINESS AUTO CONDITIONS, B.2. Concealment, Misrepresentation Or Fraud:

If you unintentionally fail to disclose any hazards existing at the inception date of your policy, such failure will not prejudice the coverage provided to you. However, this provision does not affect our right to collect additional premium for any additional hazards or exercise our right of cancellation or non-renewal.
