**RESOLUTION NO. 25-XXXX**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF CORAL GABLES, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENGAGE WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF GOVERNMENT EFFICIENCY FOR SUPPORT WITH FINANCIAL AUDITING, LONG-TERM PLANNING, AND IMPROVING FINANCIAL CONTROLS AND OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY.

**WHEREAS**, on February 24, 2025, Governor Ron Desantis issued Executive Order 25-44, creating a Department of Government Efficiency (“Florida DOGE”) within the Office of Policy and Budget in the Executive Office of the Governor; and

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order 25-44 charges Florida DOGE with recommending legislative reforms to promote efficiency, maximize productivity, and eliminate waste in state and local government; and

**WHEREAS**, engaging Florida DOGE as a part of any process relating to the creation of a comprehensive ten-year financial plan for the City, or a full audit of City expenditures, would be a strategic first step to ensure rigor, efficiency, and transparency in these processes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to authorize the City Manager to proactively engage with Florida DOGE as set forth herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CORAL GABLES:**

**SECTION 1.** That the foregoing “**WHEREAS**” clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Manager is authorized to engage with Florida DOGE to invite its collaboration with:

- a. developing a ten-year financial plan for the City;
- b. conducting a full audit of City expenditures; and
- c. providing the City with recommendations on how to improve financial controls and operational efficiency.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption herein.
